Stephen Brady: Exposing the Corrupt and Godless Hierarchy

Stephen Brady founded RCF in 1996 and has been its acting President since that time. He lives in Petersburg, IL with his wife Jo-Ann and is father of 7 children and grandfather of 12. He ran a construction company for 20 years and, thanks to the assistance of a good and holy priest, he returned to the Catholic faith over 40 years ago and has dedicated his life to assisting in the restoration of the Catholic Church.



Bob O'Donnell: Living After My Rape by a Catholic Priest

Robert O'Donnell is a 57-year-old former US Marine. He is father of 3 grown children and 5 grandchildren. He is the logistics manager for the largest manufacturer of elevator equipment in the US. In Bob's talk, he will recount when, as a teen, he was raped and sexually abused by a Catholic priest, and how to date the diocesan hierarchy has refused to respond to his pleas to have his plight heard or to help him in any way. Bob will further detail his efforts to survive following the destruction of his youthful innocence.



Jo Brady: <u>The Casualties of Warfare</u>

Jo grew up on a farm in central Illinois. She is the wife of Stephen for 39 years and a board member of RCF. She has 7 children who were all homeschooled and is grandma to 12 grandchildren. In her presentation, Jo will describe the very real and difficult challenges that Catholics must face when they make a concerted effort to fight for the Faith. As a mother who raised her children in the home, she has experienced serious and painful casualties in her family. The devil constantly tries to disenchant and discourage us from staying the course, and he often attacks us by assaulting the ones we love the most.



Elizabeth Yore: The New World Order Pope and Building the Resistance

Elizabeth Yore is an international child protection attorney specializing in missing, abducted, and exploited children. She previously served as Special Counsel at Harpo Productions for 5 years. In that position, she acted as Oprah Winfrey's Child Advocate and Attorney. Prior to that position, Liz was General Counsel for the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services where she investigated clergy abuse cases and formerly held the role of General Counsel and International Director at the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children.



James Bendell:
Bishops Behaving Badly, and How We Can Stop Them

Jim obtained his law degree from Rutgers Law School following his graduation from the College of William and Mary and has been in practice for 42 years. After working as a prosecutor he conducted jury trials for insurance companies for 16 years and presently represents individuals in a variety of civil litigation. In addition to his work in private practice Mr. Bendell served as a Superior Court Commissioner and Judge Pro Tem in Washington State. He has represented Catholics for the American Catholic Lawyers Association in New York, Maine, Idaho and Washington, and in the U.S. Supreme Court. He currently practices law in Washington State and Idaho, where he and his wife Marianne live near their two children and three grandchildren.
